PRESCHOOL

3 YEAR OLD PROGRAM (3 DAYS)

- Meets Three Days Per Week (M/T/TH or M/W/F) 8:30am-11:30am
- \$255/Month
- Must be 3 years old by August 1st

HOW TO APPLY:

Complete Registration Form

Pay the Non-Refundable Registration Fee (\$135)

A supply fee of \$165is due in August. *

*Supply fees cover all supplies including art, academic, gross motor skills, and sensory activities for students.



4 YEAR OLD PROGRAM (3 DAYS)

- Meets Three Days Per Week (M/T/TH 8:30am-11:30am
- \$255/Month
- Must be 4 years old by August 1st

4 YEAR OLD PROGRAM (5 DAYS)

- Meets five days per week (M-F)
 8:30 am 11:30 am
- \$320/Month
- Must be 4 years old by August 1st

KINDERGARTEN READINESS PROGRAM (5 DAYS)

- Meets five days per week (M-F) 8:30 am - 11:30 am
- \$320/Month
- Must be 4 years old by June 1st
- The Kindergarten Readiness Program (KRP) is designed for students who do not make the birthday cutoff date for kindergarten, or for students who would benefit from another year of preschool due to maturity or academic progress. It is not meant to replace the four-year-old program.

ADDITIONAL ENRICHMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Enrichment Hours

- 11:45 am-2:00pm on student's scheduled day
- Lunch (provided by family) and a variety of lessons in, STEM, Art, Social Skills, and more.

Enrichment Tuition

- 3 Day Program \$160 a month
- 5 Day Program \$210 a month
- Enrichment costs are in addition to preschool tuition.

ACADEMIC APPROACH

INTERVENTION SERVICES

We recognize that every child has unique strengths, struggles, and circumstances. That is why we screen early and often to identify any areas where our students need assistance or can be challenged further.

Our holistic approach treats the whole child, not just the delay or disability. We work directly with the child and with parents to plan and implement practices that will help our students thrive.

We begin screening in Kindergarten with the diocesan MAP screening and the STAR Reading and Math assessments. Screenings continue regularly through all grades.

SPEECH & LANGUAGE SERVICES

We offer assessments for all speech and language skills including articulation (speech sounds), expressive and receptive language skills, pragmatics (social language), voice, and fluency.

If a child would benefit from speech services an Alternative Learning Plan (ALP) is written that includes longterm and short-term goals. They may be seen individually, within a small group, or in the classroom.

Parents and teachers are involved and informed through every step of the process to cooperatively provide the best solution for our students.

COUNSELING

We are happy to offer students counseling on an individual basis or in groups. A wide range of topics can be covered. Popular topics include (but are not limited to):
